



Where We Are

If you are interested in joining us for our Sunday Service, or any of the events that take place here at our Church, then you'll need to know where to find us, we have put together this simple document that will show you some of the key routes to our Church via car, train and bus. We are easily accessible from most areas of Birmingham from many main transport routes, so we are sure you'll find it easy to join us here at Erdington Six Ways Baptist Church.

Below is a map of the surrounding area of our church with landmarks of local shops and the church site based on the Six Ways island in Erdington.



Getting here by car: (Sat Nav: B24 8AD)

From Birmingham City Centre:

Make your way onto the Aston Express Way until you reach the Spaghetti Junction, bare left onto Gravelly Hill North (sign posted as Erdington) and follow up to Six Ways Island, the Church is found on your 4th exit, Wood End Road.

From North Birmingham/Sutton Coldfield:

Follow the Birmingham Road from Sutton Coldfield through Wylde Green, continuing on to the Sutton Road and Sutton New Road, until you reach Six Ways Island, the church is found on your 2nd exit, Wood End Road.

From the M6 Motorway:

Leaving the Motorway at M6 J6 and take the second exit from the roundabout onto Gravelly Hill North, (sign posted as Erdington) and follow up to Six Ways Island, the Church is found on your 4th exit, Wood End Road.

Getting here by train:

There are several train stations surrounding the Church, the nearest two being Gravelly Hill and Erdington. Both stations are on the main line between Birmingham New Street and Sutton Coldfield/Lichfield. If you wish to travel from Perry Barr & Witton stations, then Aston is a linking station between the two routes, and trains from Aston will run to both Gravelly Hill and Erdington, in the direction of Sutton Coldfield/Lichfield.

Getting here by bus:

The main bus routes (which operate on a Sunday) consist of:

11A/11C, which runs circular from Perry Barr, Bearwood, Cotteridge, Kings Heath, Acocks Green then Erdington.

966, which covers a route between Solihull and Erdington.

28 (28B on Sundays) services a route between Small Heath (Heartlands Hospital) through Erdington and then Great Barr.

66, 904, 905 and 915 Which all between Sutton Coldfield and Birmingham City Centre.
